Men's Artistic Gymnastics

This is the first year that Okanagan Gymnastics has ever had a team of Men's Artistic Athletes at BC Championships.

Cody Briggs competed in the Men's National Open category. Briggs earned a bronze medal on the high bar.

The Men's Provincial level 1 category is a developmental category where each athlete earns either a gold, silver, or bronze ribbon based on their total score for that event, although scores are not flashed at this level.

Liam Dawson finished with seven gold ribbons in the category. He earned the gold on all six men's events and his all around total added to a high enough score that he also earned a gold in the all around.

Kolten Marino also finished with a gold for the all around. He earned gold ribbons on floor exercise, rings, vault, parallel bars, and high bar and a silver on the pommel horse.

Stephen Hiscock finished with three golds and four silvers. His golds were earned on the rings, vault, and parallel bars, and silver on the floor exercise, pommel horse, high bar, and all around.

Jayden Vandyk finished with three golds and four silvers. His golds were earned on the floor exercise, rings, and vault, while his silvers were earned on the pommel horse, parallel bars, high bar, and in the all around.

Jackson March finished with two golds, three silvers, and two bronzes. His golds were earned on the rings and high bar, the silvers were earned on the floor exercise, vault and all around and the bronzes were earned on the pommel horse and parallel bars.
